The History of The School

Year 1920 is the beginning of Malta's basic school with Latvian as basic language of studies.

In 1944 the basic school was renamed to the secondary school. In 1948/49 there was the first graduation from Malta's secondary school.

The old building of the school was build in 1953, the extension- in 1970 and boarding school- in 1978.

From 1962 to 1991 there were studies for Latvian and Russian children in two flows. In 1991the school was divided into Malta's 1. secondary school and 2. secondary school.

Inside The School

The school is provided with training classes. There are all necessary classrooms for each subject in the school. But material supply is not sufficient for classrooms temporarily.

In 2002 the project of renovation was started in the school that was meant to improve pupils life and studying conditions and quality.



The Quality Of Teaching Learning Process

The quality of studies is provided by professionally staff of teachers. 90% of them have higher pedagogical education, others are studying for getting higher education.

80-100% of secondary school graduates are joining universities and academies.

Each year students show very good results in competitions in different subjects in regions and in the country.

Each students in Malta's secondary school has to work out the scientific research on their own chosen them. It prepares students for studies at the universities.

Two educational programs are offered for students in the secondary school- social science program and mathematic, technical and science program.

Meals For Students

There is the canteen in the school where students can always have a good breakfast, lunch and dinner. The council of the town supports children from poor families by providing them possibility to have meals free of charge. There is also a small shop for pupils' needs.

The School's Hotel

There is a well settled hotel in the school for 60 students. 2-3 students can live in the room. There is a rest room with TV, the piano and magazines and newspaper.

Transportation

All the students who live more that 3 km far from the school get the bus to go to school free of charge.

Library

Students can get there books for each subject. There is a great amount literature and methodogical literature in the library. It offers a possibility to rear magazines and newspapers.

Computers Room

The computers' class is well equipped. There are 16 computers and all necessary stuff. Students can use Internet all the day.

<u>Activities After Lessons</u>

The school provides many activities after lessons- drama class, folks dances, choir, fashion and computers classes.

If students are interested in music they can join Malta's music school and the center of culture.

There is a big football stadium for students to have trainings in football and athletics. There are karate, basketball, volleyball classes in the gym hall.

Care Of The Students' Health

There is the nurse and dentist in the school. Psychologist and special teacher are working in the school too.
